Dear Sir or Madam:

I have been treating Jane Doe for clinical depression and anxiety since September 1997. In this time, she has been hospitalized twice for a seven and three day period at St. Vincent's Hospital in Harrison, NY.

Ms. Doe complies with her monthly appointments, daily prescription medications and weekly individual therapy with Jane Jones, C.S.W. She also meets weekly with her vocational counselor, Don Fitch, M.S. at the Center for Career Freedom where Ms. Doe is enrolled in their computer training program.

Ms. Doe is currently receiving Social Security Disability (SSD) and has applied for Section 8 housing assistance. She has virtually no assets, significant liabilities and receives financial counseling.

In my opinion, her psychiatric disability is exacerbated by her financial situation, which in turn effects her ability to recover sufficiently to pursue gainful employment.

It would alleviate Ms. Doe's condition if Chase Bank could arrange for a reduction of Ms. Doe's debt. It would be appreciated if Chase Bank is able to help with her recovery.
